Christ and Culture: Postmodernism | Pastor Ben McGowan



Is Christianity uniquely and exclusively true, or are all belief systems and traditions equally true?

For centuries, truth was considered to be something objective and absolute - something which human beings discovered and did not invent. However, in the last several decades, Postmodernism has arisen to challenge the concept of truth, asserting that what we call “truth” is merely a culture-specific interpretation or opinion, and that all such cultural interpretations were equally true and meaningful. As such, Christianity, according to

Postmodernism, is just one group’s opinion that is just as good as any other group’s. In this class, we will examine the nature of truth, the Postmodern challenge to truth, and the Christian response to Postmodernism. We will be discussing some fairly heady things, but all are welcome to attend. It is recommended that you bring a notebook to take notes during class.
